
#### **ROMA PENDANT | ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

#### Step 1




 Adjust the two mounting housings A into a preferred height position firstly.

#### Step 2



Put both left & right power cords through the mounting housing B and then fasten both cords by using the 8 shape knot till firmed.

#### Step 3



 Connect the lamp power cords to the driver according to the "+"&"-". Make sure the positive & negative are correctly wired.


- 3. Keep the lamp away from curtains, bedding linens, and any other flammable materials.
- 4. When replacing the bulb turn the lamp off and allow the lightbulb to cool.
- 5. Do not plug the lamp into multiple power strips as this may overload your electrical system.
- 6. Do not use the lamp with light dimmers.
- 7. Do not use for outdoor use.
- 8. Do not exceed the recommended wattage.
- If flickering or any other unusual issues occur with your lamp, unplug the lamp from the electrical outlet and contact a qualified electrician.
- 10. If any external damage occurs on the lamp itself or the lamp cord unplug your lamp from the electrical outlet and contact a qualified electrician to avoid any electric fires and/or injury.


Note: Do not modify or change the electrical of this lighting as this could result in fire and/or injury. Please follow assembly instructions for installation.

4. Measure the correct mounting positions for housing A & B, and then install the A & B mounting bracket housings on the ceiling

# Step 5



5. Connect the driver cords to the ceiling power cords, make sure "N"(Neutral wire) & "L"(Live wire) are correctly wired. Then fasten the mounting housing A & B on the ceiling mounting bracket housings at the end.

### Safety Precautions (please read fully and follow the instructions before installation)

- 1. Please ensure the lamp is not plugged into an electrical outlet when assembling.
- 2. Do not assemble near wet/damp areas or near gas/exhaust furnaces or fireplaces.

#### Care Instructions:

Wipe the external surfaces with a damp cloth. Use a soft cloth to wipe and polish the product, do not use sponges or steel wool. Do not use the following products for cleaning: abrasive household cleaners, acidic and/or alkaline cleaning materials, or household ammonia for cleaning.
